KWAZULU-NATAL SPORT AND RECREATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME (only for sports people with disabilities)

The KZN Department of Sport and Recreation is making available a limited number of Sport Scholarships to talented athletes for the 2022 academic year. **This time around *ONLY people with disability are encouraged to apply.* (Please note that mainstream applications has closed already)**

Purpose of the Scholarship:

- Retention and development of sporting talent in the Province.
- Providing opportunities for talented athletes from rural and historically disadvantaged areas to excel in sport.
- Support talented athletes from the Province to obtain podium positions at national and international competitions.
- Development of youth through programmes of education, skills and health.
- Provide access to accredited skills development programmes that will improve opportunities for future employment and contribute towards the alleviation of poverty.

Application Criteria:

- a. Applicants must be South African Citizens, residing in KwaZulu-Natal and whose parents/guardians are residents of KwaZulu-Natal.
- b. The Scholarship will be awarded to both learners in schools and tertiary institutions.
- c. Talented athletes who have :
 - Represented the country and excelled at international sporting competitions in a specific code/s of sport.
 - Athletes who have recorded podium positions at national competitions.
 - In the case of team sport, applicants must have played sport at national level in the previous two years and where evidence can be provided.

- Talented learners that have been identified through the implementation of the School Sport Programme and who must have represented the province at the National Primary and Secondary Schools Championships, Schools Winter, Summer or Autumn Games and where performances can be substantiated.
- Talented athletes who have been identified for the Department’s Elite Athlete Development Programme (EADP) and/or Academy and Sport Focus School System.

(All applications must be accompanied by certified Portfolio of Evidence – including, results, national and international ranking, etc)

- d. Preference will be given to applicants who are able to demonstrate the potential for academic success and which must be substantiated by the appropriate academic record.
- e. In the case of tertiary institutions applicants must also meet the requirements for enrolment in the relevant faculty or programme at a recognised Department of Higher Education, accredited tertiary institution (Universities, Universities of Technology, TVET Colleges, private colleges, etc.).
- f. Sporting performances from the period 01 January 2021 to date (taking into account COVID19 regulations where sport was not permissible).
- g. Preference will be given to applicants who are prepared to bind themselves contractually to serve the Province in their particular code/s of sport.
- h. Preference will be given to applicants who are historically disadvantaged individuals.
- i. Applicants must declare if they have an existing bursary/scholarship/funding from any other public or private institution.
