PROVINCIAL WINTER SCHOOLS SELECTION, 4-5 JUNE

The Department of Sport and Recreation together with the Department of Education in the Province is hosting the Provincial Winter Schools selections in Durban this weekend, Saturday 4 June- Sunday 5 June in Durban.

The games will serve to select leaners to represent KwaZulu-Natal in the National Winter Schools Championships also to be held in Durban next month from 9-15 July.

The codes to be played are chess, tennis, hockey, football, netball, rugby, volleyball and the indigenous games of khokho and juskei. They include both junior and senior categories and both genders. Football and netball also have DISSA /leaners with disabilities.

Unlike the Top Schools games, in the Provincial Champs leaners compete as selected district teams with a few exceptions that come in as winning schools.

The venues for the different games are as follows:

- Chess Badminton Hall (behind Moses Mabhida train station),
- Football and volleyball Cato Manor grounds,
- Hockey Queensmead,
- Khokho and tennis Hoypark,
- Netball- KwaMashu,
- Rugby Kings Park outer fields,
- Juskei- Fynnlands Sports Club, football,
- Volleyball and netball for the disabled Fulton School for the Deaf.
